

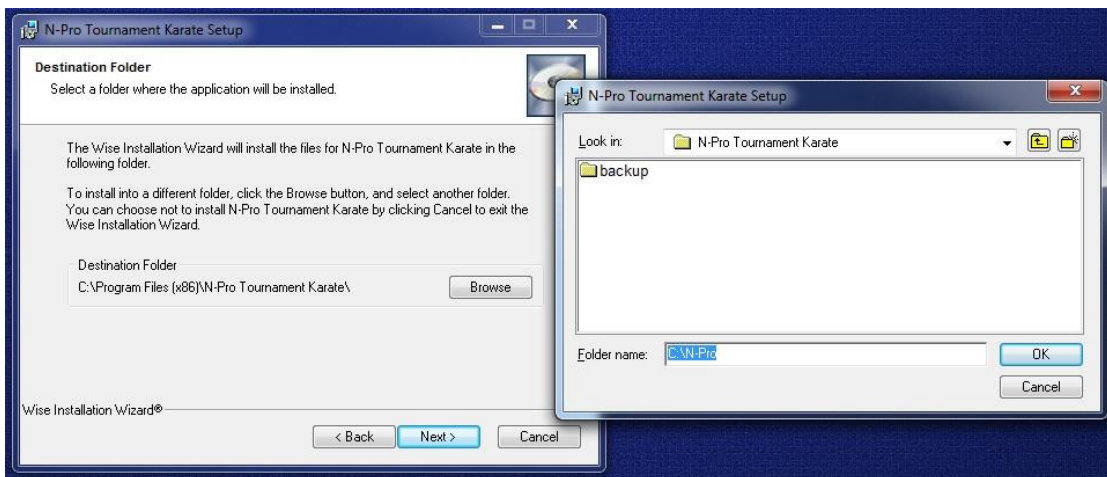
N-Pro wants to write information in its installation directory. In windows 7, 8 and windows 10 it is no longer standard allowed to do this in the “program files (x86)” folder.

Instead Windows will write the data by default in C:\Users\“Your username”\AppData\Local\VirtualStore\Program Files (x86)\N-Pro Tournament Karate. (AppData is standard a hidden folder)

This will work ok, but it is difficult if you want to access the data manually

This is how to solve it.

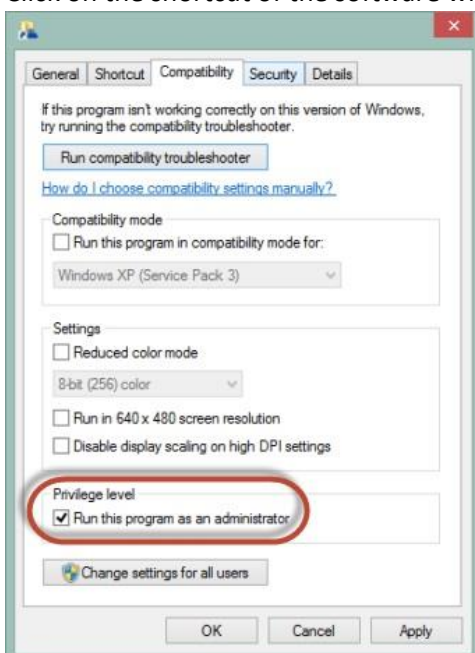
- 1- Uninstall the software.
 - 2- Go to “c:\program files (86)” and completely remove the folder “N-Pro Tournament karate”
 - 3- Re-install the software but choose a different folder to install the software. For example “c:\N-Pro” or whatever you like, as long it is not in the “program files (86)” folder.
- Then the software works fine.



When you absolutely want the software to be installed in “program files (86)”, we advise to run the software as administrator, so it will be able to write in its own installation folder.

This is how to do that:

Click on the shortcut of the software with your right mouse button and select properties.



In the compatibility tab you must check “Run this software as administrator”. Close the screen and start the software. Now the software will be able to write in its own installation folder.
